- E-mail

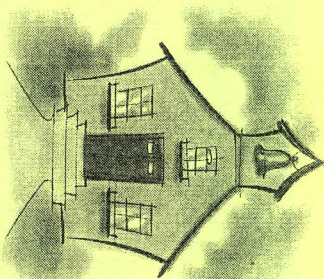


Tips for a Successful School Year
